
MPA Maritime Singapore Education Series 2021

MPA started the Maritime Singapore Green Initiative in 2011 to promote clean and green shipping in Singapore, with the aim to reduce the impact of shipping and related activities on the environment. A total of up to \$100 million was committed to be invested in this initiative for a period of five years, covering areas on green shipping, green port, green energy and technology, as well as green awareness. This is to encourage maritime companies to start using clean and green ways for shipping, and to go beyond the minimum requirements set out by the IMO.

Besides Singapore's strong commitment to environmentally-friendly shipping and port activities, MPA also works very closely with universities and the maritime industry in areas of marine research and clean technologies for projects such as developing a cleaner fuel for ships to use that will be less harmful to the environment.

In 2019, MPA created the first Maritime Sustainability Reporting Guide for maritime companies to follow. This is a very useful guide to help maritime companies be more aware of their sustainability efforts in their businesses, which helps them keep track of their green practices and the impact their work has on the environment in the long run.
